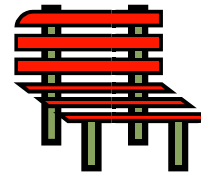

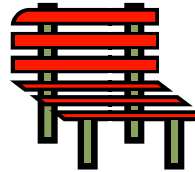

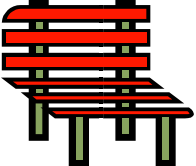
2) Draw and label a picture of the butterfly garden. Explain what you added and why you added it.
